The college of education is not changing GPA requirements for admission into the college.

The college will continue to require PRAXIS II for teacher education students

PRAXIS I/21st Century regulations have not been finalized.

Electronic data management system (TK20) is under way with the foundation work being done now.

Specialty area standards have been finalized and are available electronically to teacher educators. The Associate Dean's office is currently working to have this information ready today.

The status of M Programs, graduate programs are not finalized as of right now.
