**1. Approval of Minutes from the October 29, 2009 meeting:**

**College of Arts and Sciences:  
Department of Geology**

GLY-1        Change the program description of the Bachelor of Science degree in Geology, Secondary Education (243A/13.1399([T]) (with teacher licensure).

*Proposal was approved with wording in the proposed program description that references "instructional assistance" not be deleted but be retained by moving the phrase to "GLY 3520 for one semester hour of instructional assistance in GLY 1101 Lab."*

**3. Update on Core Curriculum (Professional Core)**

Dr. Jenkins informed the Council that the work on the re-visioning of the professional core was continuing with the proposed changes beginning the approval processes through the various bodies. Work will continue on further development of the courses and field experiences. She reminded everyone of the information sent last week to each member of the Council that included an overview of the re-visioning of the Core, course descriptions, and syllabi for each of the new courses. Dr. Jenkins asked that any questions, comments, or suggestions members might have could be sent to her and/or Dr. Duke. For anyone who did not receive the overview and the syllabi sent out last week, please notify the Dean's Office and they will be sent.

**4. Update on Graduate Programs**

Dr. Jenkins gave a brief update on the status of the re-visioning of all graduate teacher education programs and the new NC Standards for Graduate Teacher Candidates. There are approximately ten programs be involved in re-visioning programs to meet the new standards and approval process for NC. Meetings have begun with faculty to begin this process. Blueprints for the revision and how we will demonstrate that our candidates meet the revised must be submitted to DPI by July 1, 2010. (See Attached.)
