- 1. Approval of Minutes from the March 18, 2010 meeting:**  
*Due to a lack of quorum, approval of minutes will be presented at next meeting.*
- 2. Discussion of Quality Assurance Plan:** Council members gave input into the QA Plan that was presented at last meeting. This plan is on hold due to funding issues and a lack of a workable plan. Members were encouraged to continue to seek ideas and to find out about other institutions plans. There will be an ongoing effort to gather information and to formulate a workable plan.
- 3. Update on Transition Plan:** Thus far, the Transition Plan is running smoothly. Classes are filling and any questions or concerns have been addressed. Notes have been posted on the Registrar's website to refer students seeking old course numbers to the new course information. Emails and other methods of communication have been used to notify advisors, program coordinators, etc. about issues that have arisen or to provide information to them.
- 4. Tk20 Update:** Robert Dodd reported that currently we have over 1,000 users in the Tk20 program. It is expected that very soon assessment data will be required for accreditation purposes so the use of this program will become more and more important. Currently the elementary education program is using Tk20 and we're in the process of bringing the middle grades education program on board. It is hoped that funding will continue to be provided for this important part of our education process.
