Top 3 readers from each grade at each school will receive a voucher to attend a 2009-2010 Appalachian State Men's or Women's Basketball game.

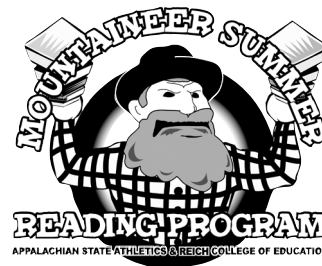
